

Kickoff - The Game Reveal

Teams around from the world gathered to watch this season's game reveal on January 6th. This music themed year's challenge, Crescendo, details a game of scoring rings (notes) in different slots (amps and speakers) on the playing field. In the last 20 seconds of the the game, robots must get on stage by hanging from a chain.

Let the build season begin!

Immediately after the Crescendo game reveal, our team discussed our strategy and robot design. We have less than 8 weeks to design, build and program our robot to have it ready for competition in Duluth on March 1st & 2nd.





January practices have been filled with prototyping, designing and building our robot. We are so fortunate to have fabrication tools available to us at our high school. This allows us to make our own parts, which teaches our team members valuable skills and reduces the cost of our robot. Besides building the robot, we also build field elements out of wood to simulate the playing field at competition.


Central MN Robotics Hub

We will be competing at Northern Lights Regional in Duluth again this season. We were very successful last season, finishing 3rd place!


